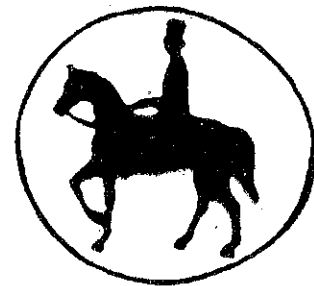

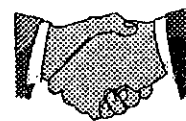
## MEMBERSHIP DRIVE CONTINUES
